

**KUSHLA WATER DISTRICT
WATER USER'S AGREEMENT**

This agreement between the **Kushla Water District**, hereinafter called the "DISTRICT", and the undersigned water user, hereinafter called the "WATER USER",

WITNESSETH

That, whereas the WATER USER desires to purchase water for domestic, commercial, agricultural, industrial or other uses from the *District* and to enter into a *User's Agreement* as required by the by-laws of the *District*.

Now therefore in consideration of the mutual covenants, promises and agreements herein contained, it is hereby understood and agreed:

1. The *District* shall furnish water meeting the quality standards set by the Alabama Department of Environmental Management, Water Division-Water Supply Program (ADEM Admin. Code 4. 335-7), subject to the requirements and limitations provided by the By-Laws and Service Rules and Regulations hereinafter provided for, such quantity of the water as the *Water User* may desire and the *District* agrees to provide. (July 2010)

2. The *Water User* shall install and maintain at his own expense a service line which shall begin at a point designated by the *District* at his property line and extend to the dwelling and other portions of his premises. A well may not be connected to the water system even if cutoff valves are used.

3. The *Water User's* service line shall connect with the distribution system of the *District* at the place designated by the *District* provided the *District* has determined in advance that the *District's* water system is of sufficient capacity to permit delivery of water to that point.

4. The *Water User* shall pay for such water at such rates, time and place as shall be determined by the *District*. Rates for individual *Water Users* presently are:

<u>Residential 3/4" Meter</u>	
0-2000 Gallons	\$17.00
Over 2000 Gallons	\$ 3.25*
	*Per Thousand Gallons

5. The *District* shall purchase and install a cutoff valve and water meter, in each service, provided use of water is immediately desired. Such cutoff valve shall be installed either off the *Water User's* premises, or upon the *Water User's* property, within three (3) feet of the property line. The *District* shall have exclusive right to use such cutoff valve and water meter and to turn it off and on.
